## **FBINAA Golf Outing**

Built in 2003, Compass Pointe has two 18-hole championship courses to choose from spread over 800 acres, a comprehensive practice facility with grass tees, and a full-service restaurant. The fairways and tees on the front nine of the Northeast are Bent grass and the back nine is Latitude Bermuda Grass. The fairways and tees on the Southwest course are all Latitude Bermuda Grass (the facility will determine which course is played).

Transportation will be provided from the host hotels to Compass Pointe, with a four-person scramble teeing off at 8:30 AM. The tournament will include lunch. After the tournament, participants will be returned to the conference hotels in time for the Opening Ceremonies.






